One polished natural corundum "Rushmore" carving measuring 20.70 x 12.90 x 9.80 centimeters, weighing 3.20 kilograms, graded by GIA, identified by GIA as a natural corundum. Displaying transparent to opaque transparency, with additional minerals present throughout the stone; The overall color of this ruby is predominantly an even purplish red color. With medium to medium dark tone and moderate saturation. Recorded under GIA report # 2235620368, recorded on July 2nd, 2025. Although this carving is predominantly red there is a significant white calcite intrusion or veins of white calcite as well as other trace elements, including full crystal structures within the calcite veining; Most of the veining is on the front and can also be seen on the faces. Although GIA and my findings conclude that this specimen is a natural corundum. The GIA report indicating just the species and not the specific variety is based off of lack of gem quality
